<b>Outcome 43A: Effectively present information*</b> (Focuses on grabbing audience interest and supporting ideas with visuals/media)*	I use explicit and highly creative techniques to immediately grab and maintain the audience's interest. I expertly clarify and support my dinosaur facts using highly effective visuals and media techniques.	I use good techniques to grab the audience's interest and keep them engaged for the minute. I clearly support my dinosaur facts using appropriate visuals and media techniques.	I attempt a "hook" to grab interest, but might lose the audience's attention at times. I use some visuals or media techniques to support my facts, but they could be clearer or more engaging.	I struggle to grab or maintain audience interest. I use very few visuals or media techniques, making it hard to understand my dinosaur facts.	I do not use techniques to grab audience interest. <b>Outcome 33A: Organize &amp; record information*</b> (Focuses on creating a media text with well-developed ideas and sections)*	My 1-minute video is perfectly organized with highly developed ideas and clear, logical sections (e.g., physical traits, diet, habitat). My research is seamlessly built into an engaging media text.	My video is well organized with developed ideas and clear sections. Most of my research is successfully combined into a clear media text.	My video has some organization, but my ideas or sections might jump around a bit. I include my research, but it sometimes feels more like reading a list than an organized video.	My video lacks clear organization or sections. My ideas are underdeveloped, and my research facts are missing or poorly put together. - **+1 to +3 Points:** The student includes highly creative, witty, or surprisingly funny elements (e.g., a funny voice, a clever joke about the dinosaur's diet, or a creative visual gag) that enhance the presentation without taking away from the educational facts.
